When: May 15 – May 31:

Where: Kenya – 5 distinct eco-cultural settings:

- Brackenhurst (montane highlands, Kikuyu)
- Lake Baringo (rift valley lakes, Ilchamus)
- Kakamega (remnant tropical rainforest, Luhya/Luo)
- Sigor (rift valley escarpment, Pokot)
- Mara/Serengeti (savannah/acacia woodland, Masai)

What: “Kutana” is a Swahili word signifying ‘mutual encounter’ and is the guiding ethos of Africa Exchange. [Kutana Kenya](#) is a two-week mission immersion experience in a cross-cultural setting in one of the most ecologically diverse environments on earth. Participants will encounter and engage people, projects, ecosystems and places of significance, all in the context of a developing nation grappling with multiple social and environmental challenges.

Who: Students – seminary/graduate students drawn from a cross-section of seminary and divinity schools. Facilitators - comprised of local and international staff led by Sam & Melody Harrell of Africa Exchange.

Why: Through cross-cultural exposure, experience and service-learning, inspire participants to become agents of transformation, leaders in *renewing God’s world* in their circles of influence. There is no substitute for actual exposure to what is real!
